1. Opening Ceremony:

- The event commenced with an invocation song performed by Ms. Aarya Borker.
- A warm welcome address was delivered by Dr. Takappa R, Chief Librarian.
- Mrs. Deepti Hanjunkar, Assistant Librarian, introduced the Chief Guest.
- The dignitaries on stage inaugurated the program with the ceremonial lighting of the lamp.



2 Message on the Progrm by Dr. Takappa R:

- Dr. Takappa R spoke about Dr. S. R. Ranganathan's seminal contributions to library science, including the Five Laws of Library Science and the Colon Classification system.
- He provided an overview of the library's progress over the past year, highlighting key developments and achievements.

Library Progress Report by Dr. Takappa R

1. Developmental Activities:

- Formation of the Library Advisory Committee to guide strategic planning.
- Creation of a Library Procedural Manual to streamline operations.
- Integration of new technology including the launch of the library website, Koha-ILS, DSpace, and QR Code Technology.

2. User Engagement:

- Conducted a User Orientation Program for 400+ students across 20 batches, providing essential training on library resources.
- Implementation of a Book Bank Scheme to support students with essential textbooks.
- Introduction of the Library Best User Award to recognize frequent library users.



3. Notable Events

- The 2023 Librarians Day Celebration on August 18, 2023, with Dr. Murari Tapaswi as the Chief Guest.
- Organization of a Book Exhibition to showcase new library acquisitions.
- Hosting of a National Level Librarian Development Program, a five-day event aimed at enhancing professional skills.

4. Recent Developments

- Collection Development: Addition of 10,500 new books, including 1,500 reference books and 9,000 textbooks, bringing the total to over 35,000 books. Expansion of databases with the addition of five new resources, making a total of 25 available.
- Technological Enhancements: Installation of a new RFID Self-Issue Kiosk for efficient transactions.
- Innovative Services: Introduction of services like Daily News Clipping, Journal Current Content Bulletin, and "Ask a Librarian – Question Point" for real-time assistance.
- Library Expansion: Enhancement of seating capacity by 50 with innovative furniture, and preparatory visits to top libraries in India for planning future expansion.
