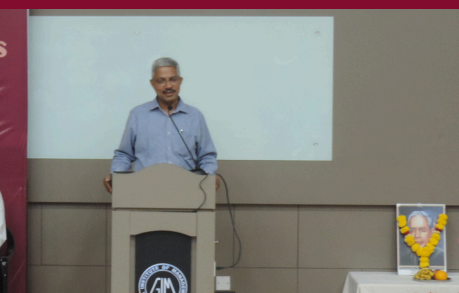

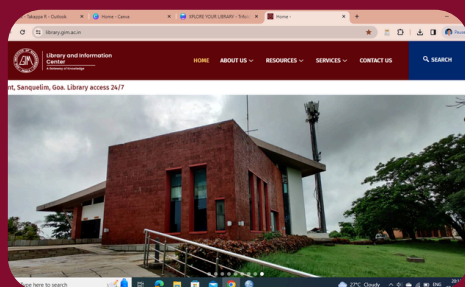

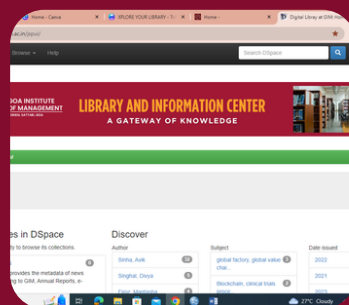
### Library Website

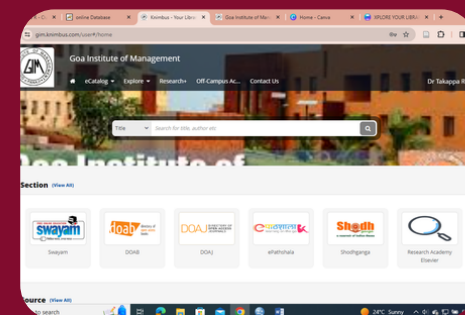

## Library Instructions

- Silence, decorum, and discipline must be maintained in the library. The mobile phone keeps in silent mode.
- Smoking, eating, sleeping, and talking are strictly prohibited in the library.
- Documents taken out of the shelves must be left on the table. Replacing the books on shelves is not encouraged as they may get misplaced.
- A misplaced book is like a lost book. A non-member can refer to library resources on the premises with the permission of the Chief Librarian.
- Readers should not mark, underline, crinkle, write, tear pages, or damage the library documents.
- Newspapers, magazines, and journals must be read only in the library on designated tables and should not be taken to other reading areas.
- The unauthorized removal of anything belonging to the library will be treated as theft and dealt with accordingly.
- Anyone who violates the rules and regulations of the library would be liable to lose the privilege of library membership and may be debarred from using the library facilities.
