GIM Library: At a Glance

The Library at GIM has been a part of the institute since its inception in 1993. Back then, it was operating from the Ribandar Campus, Near Panaji, with a collection of a little over 10000 books and couple of staff members. In the year 2011, the Library has been shifted to present campus at Sanquelim.

The Library aims to provide a user-friendly platform to all users to access print and online resources without any hassle through KOHA OPAC along with remote access facility. The library is fully automated with KOHA open source software for daily housekeeping operations of the library across the campuses. Currently, GIM Library has more than 35000 print books, 75 print journals, more than 20000+ e-journals, around 25000 e-books and 25 online databases.

GIM subscribes to all relevant academic databases including Bloomberg Terminals, Thomson Reuter Terminals, CMIE Databases, EBSCO, Proquest, Indiastat, EPWRFITS, J-Stor, Science Direct, Indian Business Insight (IBI), and more.

RFID Technology provide much needed security and self-supported borrowing facility for the users.

CMIE: Industry Outlook	Industry Outlook helps you anticipate trends in 209 industries. Industry Outlook is your risk management tool. It helps you prepare to better ride the business cycles while anticipating the future.
CMIE: Prowess IQ	ProwessIQ is an interactive querying system to find companies from the Prowess database. It consists of a client software that provides an interface to construct and submit queries over the internet to the Prowess database and receive answers to the queries from the database.
CMIE: States of India	If you need a source of reliable and comprehensive information on the Indian markets, then, States of India is your best option. The service is designed to meet your regular requirements of regional data and news. India consists of 37 states and union territories, or more importantly, it consists of 724 districts. 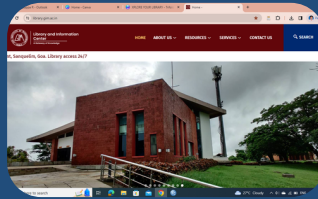

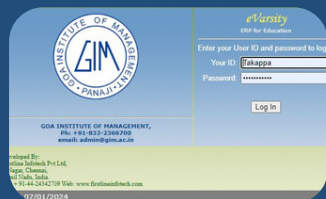
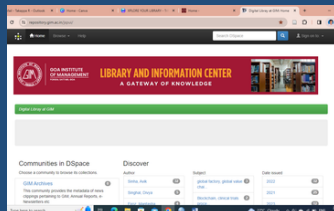
All transactions of the library material like an issue, return, renewal and hold are done through Koha.

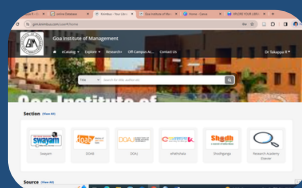
ERP (E-Varsity)

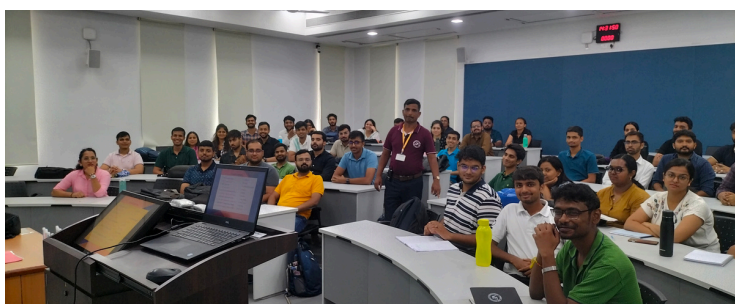

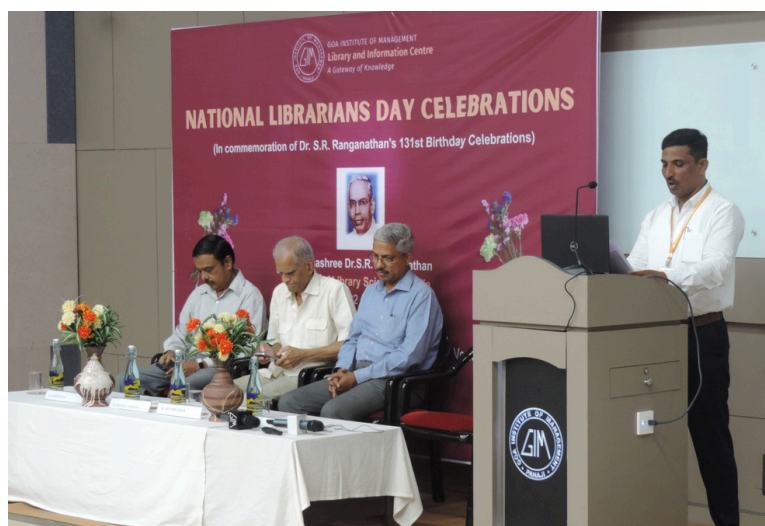
Library Orientation Program

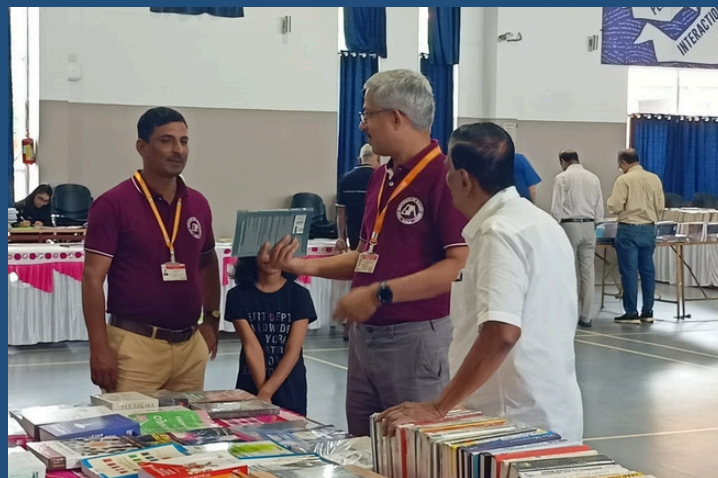
Librarians Day Celebration 2023
