1. Opening Ceremony:

- The dignitaries on stage inaugurated the program with the ceremonial lighting of the lamp.

• Dr. Takappa R welcomed all the dignitaries and the audience. He spoke about Dr. S. R. Ranganathan's seminal contributions to library science, including the Five Laws of Library Science and the Colon Classification system.

Library Progress Report by Mrs. Deepti Hanjunkar, Assistant Librarian

This report provides an overview of the progress and developments in our library over the past year, highlighting key activities and advancements that have strengthened our library services and infrastructure.

1. Collection Development

- Addition of 1,500 new books, and the total collection of the books is 27000
- Expansion of Science Direct database from 140 journals to 525

2. Technological Enhancements:

• Migrating the remote access platform from Knimbus to OpenAthens, a globally standard and secure platform.



3. User Engagement

- **User Orientation Program:** Conducted for first-year students across four batches, providing essential training on utilising library resources effectively.
- **Database Training:** Conducted selected database training for the students by the respective publishers.
- **Plagiarism Report:** Extended the service by generating more than 300 plagiarism check reports (articles & SIP) for the students and faculty.
- **Document Delivery Service:** Provided extended service by delivering over 200 articles, sourced from networking libraries, beyond our existing subscriptions.
- Book Bank Scheme: Distributed a set of textbooks to all first-year students based on the recommendation of the faculty.
- **Book Borrowing:** Enhanced the borrowing limit for students from 2 books for 5 days to 4 books for 14 days.
- Library Best User Award: Ongoing initiative to encourage and recognize the most frequent library users.

4. Notable Events

 Librarians Day Celebration 2024: Held on August 12th, 2024, with Dr. P V Konnur, Former University Librarian, Goa University, as the Chief Guest.



- Book Exhibition: Conducted to highlight new additions to the library and promote community engagement with its resources
- Book Donation Drive: A textbook (old editions) donation drive is conducted annually.
- Leadership Development Program for Library Professionals: A three-day programme enhances participants' competencies in leadership, change management, decision-making, communication, team building, and innovation through a balanced blend of interactive lectures and real-life case studies. Attended 35 participants across India.

5. Professional Development

- Dr. Takappa R participated in three national and international conferences, presented papers at the G20 Library Summit, Pondicherry University, Pondicherry; the Global Library Summit, South Asian University, New Delhi; and the National Conference on Modern Library Technologies and Services, MAHE, Bengaluru.
- Mr. Deepti Hanjunkar, Asst. Librarian, attended a 5-Day National Level Librarian Development Program organised by Narayan Zantye College of Commerce in association with the Directorate of Higher Education, Governament of Goa.
